

WestVet Referral Policy: The legal responsibility for the animal and therefore the ultimate authority for the decisions regarding the medical care of the animal rests with the veterinarian or veterinarians on duty who are physically on the premises of the hospital. The authority for decisions regarding patient care is subject to informed consent of the owner and should factor in the wishes of the primary care veterinarian, the principal veterinarian on the case, and practice philosophy and policy. The veterinarian on duty will attempt to comply with the orders of the referring doctor, specialist, or other doctor who is the principal doctor on the case and attempt to contact them, as requested or required, but reserves the right to change the diagnostic or therapeutic plan based on the patients changing condition and the decisions of the pet owner.
